Tokenomics

CAPS is distributed in a clear and community-first manner:

- **70%** — Mining Rewards
- **30%** — Liquidity Pool (locked on PancakeSwap)

No VC allocations. No whales. No secret backdoors. Just honest distribution and transparent intent.

Community First

CAPS doesn't come with buzzwords like "Web3 synergy" or "AI-powered metaverses." It's a coin that exists to exist. If you want a "serious investment," go elsewhere. If you want a fair-launched, GPU-mineable coin to tinker with, mine, and meme — **welcome to the Wasteland.**
